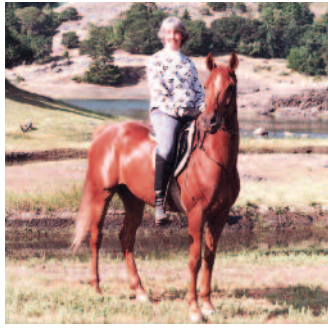

PRESERVATION AND STEWARDSHIP GRANTS

Bay Area Barns and Trails (BABT) provides technical and financial assistance to equestrians, public and private landowners, trails associations, and community groups working together to preserve San Francisco Bay Area equestrian stables, pastures, trails, and horse camps.

Application Deadlines: May 1 and November 1

Equestrian Land and Trail Stewardship Grants: \$500 - \$2,500*

*\$2500 is our maximum standard grant. However, special grants of up to \$5,000 may be available for larger projects with matching funds from other sources.

GRANT APPLICATION 2018

Bay Area Barns and Trails invites equestrians to submit funding requests for stewardship projects which will enhance, preserve, steward, or construct equestrian trails, stables, pastures, horse camps and staging areas in Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Mateo, San Francisco, Santa Clara, Solano, or Sonoma Counties.

Priority will be given to the following projects:

- Projects that preserve, promote, create or enhance access to public trails used by equestrians.
- Equestrian facilities that are connected or adjacent to public trail networks.
- Trail drainage improvements, i.e. culverts, berms, bridges, puncheons, turnpikes, waterbars, switchbacks, cribwalls; geo-web to harden trail tread, fencing to discourage shortcutting.
- Manure management: install composting bins, windrows, etc..
- Pasture management: restore native grasses and plants, including re-seeding grazing areas and removing invasive plants, install riparian buffers.
- Support for water quality enhancement and water conservation projects (such as rainwater harvesting).
- Improvements to multi-use trails, including connectors, amenities, trail purchase easements, equestrian staging areas, purchase & development rights.
- Projects with an environmental or educational component.
- Projects that have matching funding.

Private Ranches: Projects must be for public benefit and open to public riding. Grants for exclusive use trails or facilities will not be considered for funding.

Grant applications must include location, issues, problems and anticipated benefits to the equestrian community and the natural environment. Grant recipients shall submit a report within one year documenting how monies were used and with what result, and provide photos, updates or videos of the final project.

We request grant recipients list BABT as a partner on their website with a link to BABT's website. We encourage grant recipients to support BABT as a friend/donate, like us on Facebook, sign up for our e-newsletter, and request their membership to do the same.
